



**Brandywine Valley Driving Club & Delaware Valley College
Arena Driving Trial at Delaware Valley College, Doylestown, PA
Sunday, October 5, 2008**

Divisions: Training, Preliminary and Intermediate for Horse/Ponies, Single/Multiple, VSE

Official: Dressage and Cones: Jamie O'Rourke

Awards: 1-6 place per division; Best Dressage Score for Training, Preliminary and Intermediate; Best Cones Scores 1-6 place for Training, Preliminary and Intermediate; Combined Test 1-6 place for Training, Preliminary and Intermediate.

Fees: Driving Trial (All three phases) \$ 60/turnout; Combined Test \$ 40/turnout

Entries: Open September 1, 2008; Close September 22, 2008. Limited to the first 18 entries based on postmark. Because of limited entries first choice will go to entrants doing all three phases. Entries must include full payment and current Coggins OR WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. We mostly follow ADS rules (www.americandrivingsociety.org) but are not an ADS show. At Training Level times in obstacles will count (trot only).

Age: Drivers & Navigators < 18 must have signed parental consent. Drivers < 14 must be accompanied by a knowledgeable adult horseperson. Navigators must be at least 12. Equines must be at least 4.

Packets: Will be available on Sunday, October 5th starting at 7:00 am. All persons riding in a carriage (whip, navigators, passenger, etc) will be asked to sign waivers before packets are released.

Food: Will be available for purchase on the grounds Sunday.

Parking: Please observe parking signs and directions. Water available on site. Bring your own ice.

Scores: Class ribbons/packets available 30 minutes after scores are posted, barring protest. Best awards at the end of the day.

Dressage and Cones: Dressage: ADT Training Level Test 1-2005, ADT Preliminary Level Test 1-2005, ADT Intermediate Level Test 1-2005

Arena: Dressage: 24.38M x 68.58M Sand, Cones: Sand, Hazards: Sand

Dress/Eq: Low key, but correct: whip, gloves, apron in dressage and cones, helmet required
